Dear Neighbor,

Starting in the fall of 2012 there will be a new school opening in our community. The new Charter School at 2201 N. Natchez is now recruiting interested students to enroll for next school year. This school will have approximately 575 spots grades K-8 for the 2012 school year.

Last fall when negotiations about the construction of this school were taking place I promised if a school was built in our community, I would be sure that the children in the neighborhood would have a chance to attend that school. That is why working with Juan Rangel, CEO of UNO and CPS representatives I was able to identify an admission boundary that was agreed upon by all parties. This boundary which runs roughly from North Ave on the south to Belmont on the North and Central Ave on the East to Oak Park Ave on the West is designed to ensure that this new school will serve the families of our community for many years. Admission to the school will be done by a lottery of applications received. **The Deadline for applications is June 29th, 2012.**
